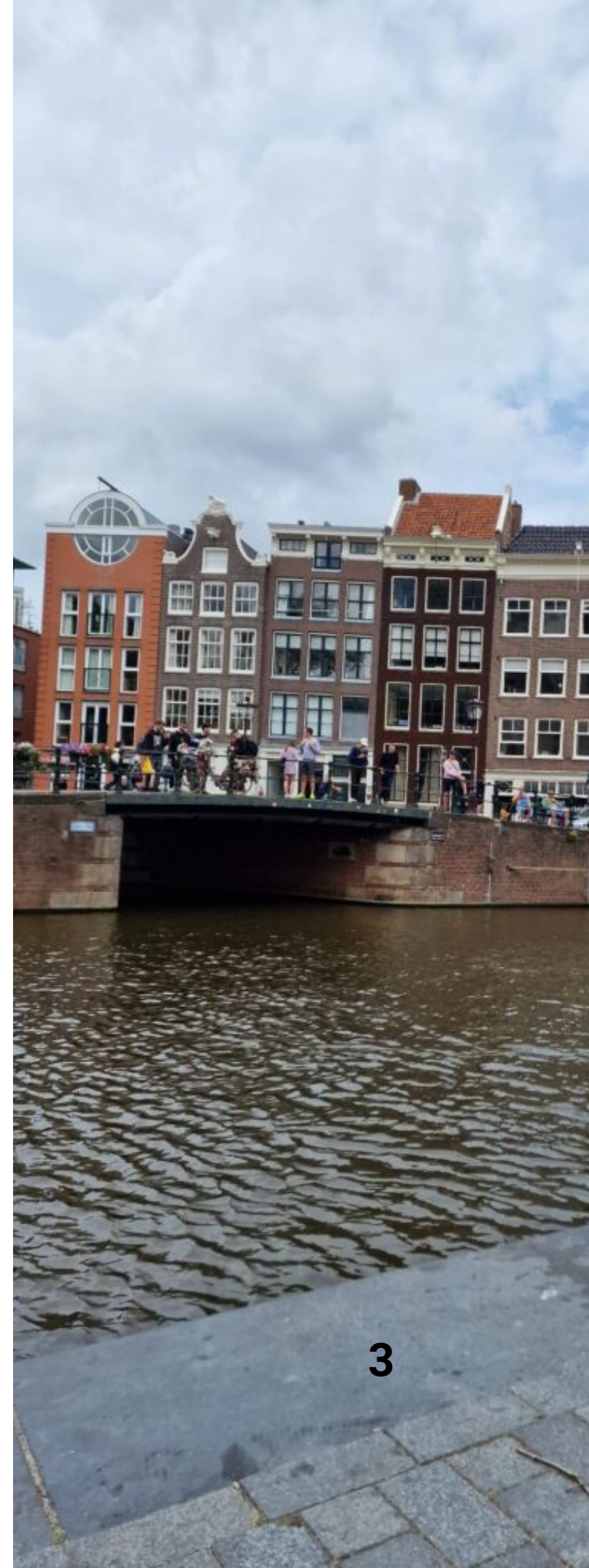

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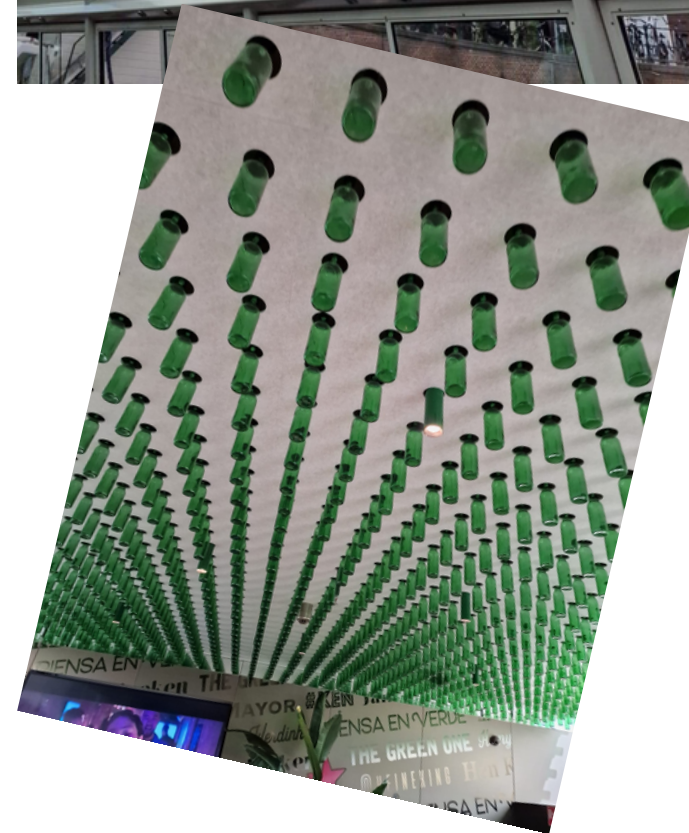
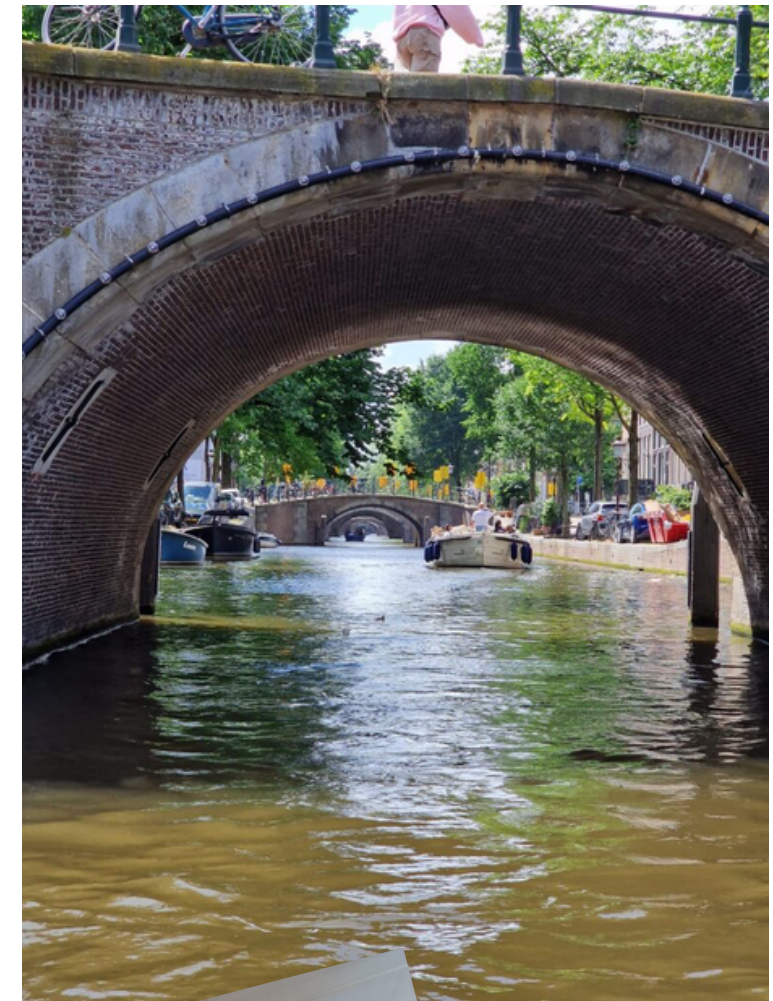
Tips

- Rent a bike – Amsterdam is extremely bike-friendly. It's the best way to explore like a local.
- Mind the bike lanes – Pedestrian and bike lanes are separate. Watch where you walk to avoid getting run over.
- Public transport – Trams, metro, buses, and river boats are efficient. [See my blog for more details](#)
- [HOSTELS](#) are the budget option to stay. If you are going with the family with kids, apartment is the best option as you have more space and options for cooking. To save money on food, buy food from supermarkets. Food can be very expensive from restaurants. If you stay in the hostels, most of them have kitchen- carrying a packet of noodle is a good option to save money. Consider hotels if you get a bargain.
- Be prepared for the weather. Weather can be bit unpredictable in Europe.
- Instead of buying a hard sim for the Internet and calls, plan for an e-sim like [HOLAFLY](#) OR [AIRALO](#)
- Try to take 2 travel money cards- I always keep one as back up. Carry some hard cash as well.
- Book entrance tickets in advance. [VIATOR](#) or [GET YOUR GUIDE](#) are good options.
- Luggage: use [BOUNCE](#) OR [NANNYBAG](#) to store your luggage if you do not have an option to store them in the hotel/ hostel cloak room.
- Take allowed baggage size for the Flight/ train /bus. Check their site for the details. Check the [Easyjet bag](#).
- Do not forget to try local beers and food.
- City passes are a good option for saving money and time. My personal choice is [Go city](#) passes.
